

Love Life Live Lent - that was the title of an initiative

which began in Birmingham Diocese in 2006, and has since been taken up much more widely. It focused on doing something positive every day through Lent to make the world a better place, rather than just giving up luxuries. Here are some ideas you might like to try, to mark Lent this year:

<u>Count</u> Your Blessings with Christian Aid - Sue Walsh writes: This year, why not join Christian Aid in their Lent journey and 'Count your Blessings'. Based on the hymn 'When I needed a neighbour, were you

there?' the Lent Calendar suggests inspiring ways for us to give, act and pray for our global neighbours and suggests ways in which we can give thanks daily for all our blessings. There are two versions of the calendar available, one for Adults and one for our younger members so everyone can get involved. The calendars will be available at the back of church.

<u>Pray</u> more - Praying on our own or with others can help us to draw closer to God. Prayer can change things - it can change us! You might like to try different ways of praying on your own (there are some ideas on the Diocese of Blackburn website, under Discipleship); get together with a couple of friends to support each other in prayer; or come to some of the midweek prayer times at Christ Church, Tuesdays at 9 p.m., Thursdays at 7 p.m. or Fridays at 9 a.m.

<u>Explore</u> your calling - Everyone is called by God; everyone has gifts and skills that can be used for God's kingdom. If you would like to find out more about yourself, and what God may be calling you to do (which could be what you're doing already!), come to the

'SHAPEd for God's Purpose' course on Thursday evenings from 2nd March to 6th April at 7.30 p.m. (after prayers), to explore your Skills, Heart's Desire, Abilities, Personality and Experience, and what they mean for your own calling. You will get the most out of the course if you come to most or all of the sessions, and do a little preparation beforehand. Sign up at the back of church.

<u>Read</u> a good book - SPCK and Church House Publishing both have a wide range of excellent Lent books, including Stephen Cottrell's 'The Things He Did' - meditations on the story of Holy Week and the things Jesus did, from his entry into Jerusalem on Palm Sunday until his arrest on Maundy Thursday; the 'Lent for Everyone' books by Tom Wright; and 'Reflections for Lent 2017' by Jeff



Astley, Libby Lane and Helen-Ann Hartley. Or browse in the Christian Book Centre in Fox St, Preston for more ideas. Let's make Lent at Christ Church a time when we all grow in discipleship and draw closer to God.
