# **Giving Thanks**

Page 1

Although largely an American tradition, Thanksgiving, celebrated this year on 22nd November, has its origins in an English Reformation tradition carried on by the pilgrims who arrived at Plymouth in 1620. Puritans celebrated days of fasting and days of feasting in gratitude for God's provision.



In an age where food consumption is far removed from food production and growth, a growing number of Christians use the holiday as a time not only to thank God for what we have, but to examine where it comes from and the ethics of food, hunger and environment. As we see the increasing work and need for local food banks, and consider the times when they have nearly run out of stock here in Preston, this feels more appropriate than ever. As followers of Jesus, we are called to a life of gratitude, not just a single day.

**Colossians 3:17** says: (The Message)

"Let every detail in your lives—words, actions, whatever—be done in the name of the Master, Jesus, thanking God the Father every step of the wav."

Everything we do and say should try and hold on to two basic characteristics:

**First**, it should be done "in the name of Jesus." For me this suggests that we are to seek his agenda and to be committed to his purposes, surrounding all we do with prayer.

**Second**, we are to do and say everything thanking God the Father. We are to act and speak thankfully. We are to live each moment with an awareness of God's grace at work in our lives and in the world around us. Sometimes we will express our gratitude to God or to others. But even when we're silent, we are to receive all of life and do all with an awareness that we are living by grace. This isn't always easy to do or remember but is something we should aspire to.

So, it only seems appropriate, as I prepare for the next chapter in my ministry in Manchester, to give thanks to God for the last three and a half years at Christ Church, and for my time of curacy. It is also right for me to thank all those who have supported me in any way during this time; to name individuals risks missing someone out, and so I thank everyone as a whole. Please do continue to pray for us as we prepare for this next adventure!!

"Do not worry about anything, but in everything by prayer and supplication with thanksgiving let your requests be made known to God. And the peace of God, which surpasses all understanding, will guard your hearts and your minds in Christ Jesus."


