

4th March - we go to Egypt and think about how
the law given by God through Moses revives us. The
Lenten journey through the wilderness is one that is not aimless
meandering, looking for spiritual succour from wherever we might find it,
but is one that requires us to be led by the Holy Spirit, and the law of God.

11th March - this week we focus on the Lebanon, where 40 per cent of the
population is estimated to be Christian, the largest percentage of Christians
of all the Middle Eastern nations.

18th March - HOPE Group: no meeting this week (Iona pilgrimage)
25th March - as we think about Jesus's triumphant arrival in Jerusalem over 2000 years ago we walk and pray with the Christians of present day Jerusalem. The Jerusalem of Jesus's time has many resonances with the Jerusalem of today: a place of occupation, with differing views as to how best to overcome this, a place of conflict and yet a place revered as holy.

Fulwood (Evening) Townswomen's Guild


