

When I first started to think about what I would write about mission and growth I thought about broad statements relating to us as a Christian community reaching out and spreading the love of God beyond our church door; how we need to think about what we already know, what we could do better, what we could change and what we could do more of.

And yes, our October Mission Month is about all of these things, and all the events are designed to get us thinking, talking, discussing and coming up with ideas together. But I have come to realise that this journey is much, much more than that. It isn't just a journey for us all together but it is also a very personal journey for all of us as Christians.

I also keep thinking (and praying) about what Jesus would do if he was on the Parish Development Group? The answer I think comes from what we know of his life. He would gather disciples around him and invite them to follow him and spread his message through where they go and what they do. He asked people with specific skills because he realised that he needed them but he also asked ordinary people to do extraordinary things beyond what they were used to. He asked them to change.

I think we are all His disciples and we all have a very important role to play in spreading His word through what we do and how we do it.

So I hope and pray that we can all continue along our personal journeys as we go together through Mission Month and beyond.


