


Blackburn Cursillo's annual Sponsored Sing: 29th April.

Rev Keith Kent Penwortham died 29th Feb, whose funeral was held on 11th March at St Andrew, Leyland.



Keith was Curate at Christ Church from 1958 to 1960.

The official notice from the Diocese says:
Revd Keith Kent was ordained in the Diocese of
Blackburn in 1958 and served his first curacy at Christ
Church Fulwood until 1960. He then served in a variety
of parishes in Liverpool until moving to Beddgelert in
1986 for five years. He retired in 1991 and returned
to the Diocese and has held 'Permission to Officiate'
since then.
