Mission-shaped Youth: Rethinking Young People and Church!

For years now there has been lots said and written about Mission Shaped Church. The premise (which I think is a correct one) is that in the UK we find ourselves in a Missionary context.

Church of England Statistics state:

1.7 million people take part in a Church of England service each month, a level that has been maintained since the turn of the millennium. Approximately one million participate each Sunday

Of that 1.7 million a very small percentage are young people. As



vouth a response to this the Church of England produced a book called: Mission-shaped Youth: Rethinking Young People and Church!

The book highlights Mission Shaped initiatives with young people and includes the work of Chaplains in our Church High Schools in Lancashire. A previous Youth Officer (now the Vicar of Christ Church !) was in contact with 100's of young people who found it a challenge being a Christian in school. As a result the Diocese rolled out a vision to have Chaplains in all of our schools; this vision is almost complete with over 10,000 young people having access to a Chaplain at school. This really is Mission Shaped Youth Work.

Archbishop Temple School is then more than just a school; it's an expression of Mission. It is our pleasure to be invited to a Celebration Service: EDUCATION SUNDAY on 16th February @ 10.30am at the SCHOOL.




