'In Christ all will be brought to life' Christian Funeral

Having battled for many years against his illness he finally lost his fight and leaves behind his wife Linda and son Russell.

Laurie was born in Liverpool and attended Waterloo Grammar school and then Liverpool University where he gained a Bachelor of Engineering degree. Laurie worked on the construction of the M62 connecting the East and West of the North of England. Laurie along with Dorothy were fully involved in Parish life and founder members of Churches Together in Fulwood and Broughton. The funeral service was memorable and full of hope. He is survived by Dorothy and their children Mike and Heather.

29th April died 20th April Neville JONES Forest Brook Neville was born in Preston, attending Kennington Road Primary School before gaining a place at the Grammar School where he excelled in athletics and tennis. He served in the RAF, representing them at tennis and he even played at Wimbledon. Recently illness caused him to move to St Catherine's Hospice where he remained until he passed away.
