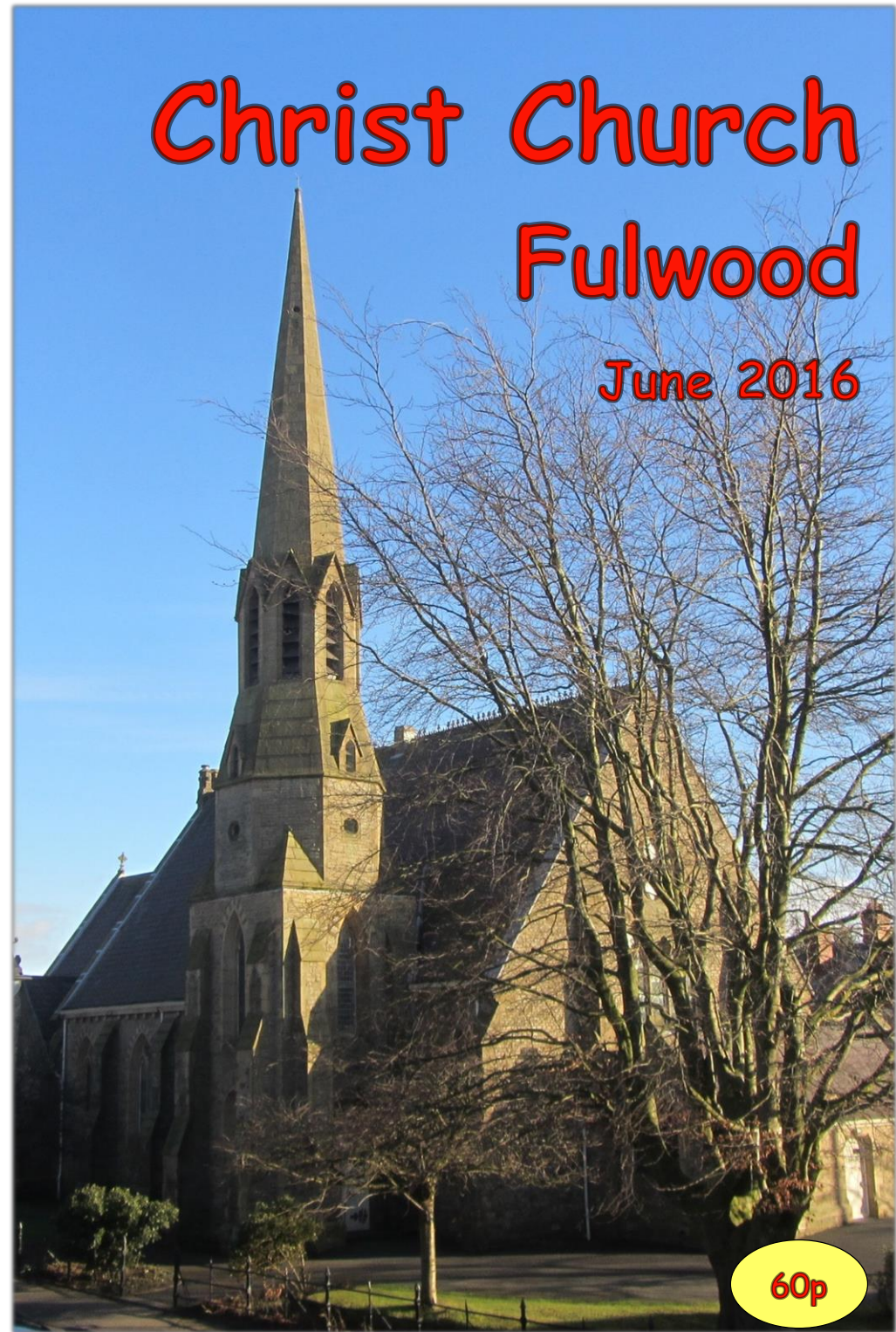

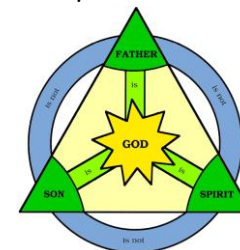

## Christian Funeral

'In Christ all will be brought to life'

22<sup>nd</sup> April John **HAYES** Hoyle Lane died 9<sup>th</sup> April

John was a keen cyclist in his younger years and loved cycling in the Lake District and also enjoyed diving and flying. John was renowned for his DJ work around Preston throughout the 70's and 80's. Having battled for many years against his illness he finally lost his fight and leaves behind his wife Linda and son Russell.

26<sup>th</sup> April Laurence ("Laurie") **BRADLEY** died 10<sup>th</sup> April

Laurie was born in Liverpool and attended Waterloo Grammar school and then Liverpool University where he gained a Bachelor of Engineering degree. Laurie worked on the construction of the M62 connecting the East and West of the North of England. Laurie along with Dorothy were fully involved in Parish life and founder members of Churches Together in Fulwood and Broughton. The funeral service was memorable and full of hope. He is survived by Dorothy and their children Mike and Heather.

29<sup>th</sup> April Neville **JONES** Forest Brook died 20<sup>th</sup> April

Neville was born in Preston, attending Kennington Road Primary School before gaining a place at the Grammar School where he excelled in athletics and tennis. He served in the RAF, representing them at tennis and he even played at Wimbledon. Neville was a member of the choir here at Christ Church along with his brother, Alan, and his father; he was a regular Communicant at 8am for many decades. Recently illness caused him to move to St Catherine's Hospice where he remained until he passed away.

Just after Neville's funeral we were saddened to hear of the death of Alan Jones his brother - this will be remembered more fully in next Month's Magazine.

29<sup>th</sup> April Eileen **SAXON** Eastgate died 19<sup>th</sup> April

Eileen was originally from Makerfield but moved to Preston early in her life. Eileen and her late husband, Stan, were very well known at Christ Church as their home was two doors away on Victoria Rd. Being close meant Stan became our caretaker, well supported by Eileen. She is survived by her daughters Margaret and Sue.

John **HAWORTH** Chapman Road died 24<sup>th</sup> April

John (Jack) was born in Rawtenstall and attended Bacup and Rawtenstall Grammar School and following National Service took up a career in the Valuation Service. Jack lived most of his life in Rawtenstall and then Middleton and Doncaster before moving to Preston (to live with his son John and wife Janette) until he became too ill and needed hospitalisation. Recently Jack received the Legion D'Honneur medal, for his War Service whilst serving in the Royal Air Force, of which his family are extremely proud. Jack's son, John, is the newest member of our PCC!
